RULES REGARDING LEAVE:

LEAVE

- ◆ Attendance on the last working day and re-opening day is mandatory.
- ◆ Leave of absence shall be granted only on prior written application from the Parents.
- ◆ Leave letters are to be addressed to the Head teacher and forwarded either through the grade teacher or the school office.
- ◆ In case of continued absence due to illness, a medical certificate will have to be produced.
